

Dr. Uwe Schlink is a Senior Researcher at the Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research UFZ in Leipzig, Germany, and Professor at University of Leipzig, Institute of Meteorology. He is heading the research group on “urban climate and personal exposure” in the Department of Urban and Environmental Sociology. His research areas include urban air quality, urban climate research, personal exposure, and vulnerability with extreme environmental situations in urban areas, statistical modelling and Bayesian inference. He has published more than 60 articles in peer-reviewed international journals. He is an adjunct faculty of the IITM in Chennai and a fellow of the Institute of Advanced Studies at Durham University, UK.
